Dots

There is a green dot between Ancona and its nearest river. This dot **is in play**, and drawn in green to make it visible against the black outline.

Dry-erase Markers

Our findings with various colors of dry-erase markers thus far:

Brand: Expo:

- **Black:** Erases fine, but difficult to use since it matches the color of the dots.
- Blue, Dark: Erases completely, but a little dark.
- Blue, Light: Erases completely; works fine.
- Brown, Dark: Erases completely, but a little dark.
- Brown, Light: Erases completely; works fine.
- **Green, Dark**: Erases completely; works great.
- Green, Light: Erases completely; works great.
- Orange: Erases completely; works great.
- Pink: Erases completely; works great.
- **Purple:** Erases completely, but a little dark.
- Red: Erases completely; works great.
- Rose: Erases completely; works great.

Brand: Vis-à-Vis:

- Black: Erases fine, but difficult to use since it matches the color of the dots.
- **Blue:** Erases almost completely and otherwise works fine.
- **Green**: Works great and erases completely with water.
- Red: Avoid. Leaves a mark that does not erase except with Isopropyl alcohol.
